Big Sandy and his Fly-rite Boys -- Los Angeles



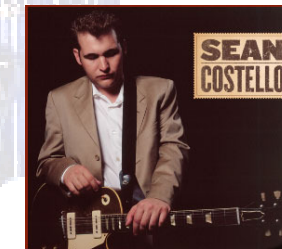

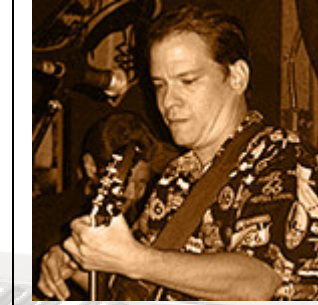

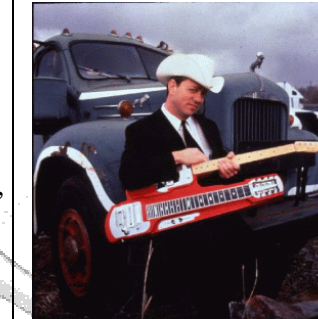
Los Straitjackets -- Nashville

honky-tonk, rock and roll, blues and more.

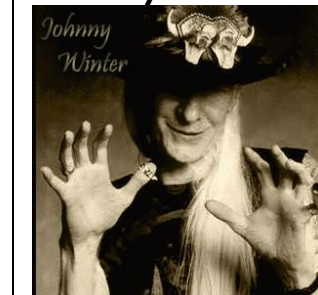
The Blasters -- Los Angeles
